TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS AT SIEW 2020

- Last evening's [SIEW Thinktank Roundtables](#) featured discussions by [Agora Energiewende](#) on the decarbonisation opportunities for Southeast Asia's economies, current developments and trends in energy policy for low carbon pathways, as well as long-term perspectives on hydrogen for future energy systems, and its impact on the region. The [Atlantic Council](#) also presented a roundtable on the 2020 US Election and its impact on US energy and climate policies.
- The Roundtable series concluded today with presentations by the [Institute of Energy Economics, Japan \(IEEJ\)](#) and the [United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific \(UNESCAP\)](#), which discussed the role of the circular economy in the future of fossil fuels, as well as the need for cross-border integration for power system sustainability and resilience across APAC.
- [Youth@SIEW](#) kicked off earlier today, with opening remarks by [Ms. Low Yen Ling](#), Minister of State (MOS) for Ministry of Trade and industry and Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth, who expounded on this year's theme of "Seizing Opportunities in a New Energy Landscape" in a dialogue session with youth.
 - MOS Low's address encouraged Singapore's youth to partner the government and co-create Singapore's energy story. She also announced the launch of two new energy video resources developed in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, which provide a glimpse into exciting and sustainable innovations in the local energy sector, with the aim of driving further interest in the industry amongst the youth.
 - Two local engineering students, Mr Gustavus Liew Zeng Kit from Ngee Ann Polytechnic, and Mr James Lum from Singapore Polytechnic, were awarded this year's [Energy-Industry Scholarship \(EIS\)](#), a dedicated scholarship for the energy sector offered in partnership with the Energy Market Authority (EMA) and industry partners. The scholarship highlights EMA's and the industry's commitment to build a strong pipeline of local talent, to power Singapore's critical infrastructure.
 - The virtual tour of this year's SIEW Youth Energy Showcase saw presentations from six institutes of higher learning — Republic Polytechnic, Nanyang Technological University, National University of Singapore, Singapore Institute of Technology (Newcastle University), Temasek Polytechnic and Singapore Polytechnic — who showcased their energy innovations and prototypes on the themes of decarbonisation and digitalisation. The remaining presentations by Ngee Ann Polytechnic, ITE College East and ITE College Central may be viewed on [Swapcard](#).
